School Board Meeting April 18, 2016

Before the meeting started a group of Elementary students sang a couple of songs for the board and the people that were in attendance. They were accompanied by Mrs. Johnson the music teachers. The students did a really good job and everyone enjoyed it.

J.C. Copas called the regular school board meeting to order. Secretary Laura Bell, members Andie Mears Don Mills, and Steve Christopher were present. Also present was Superintendent Mrs. Cathy Rowe, potential Attorney Robert Little and Treasurer Jody Morgan. The pledge was recited and the meeting began.
